Dear members of the Northwestern community,

Earlier today, Illinois Governor J.B. Pritzker announced he will sign an order extending the state's "stay-at-home" order through April 30. In response, Northwestern also is extending through April 30 its [guidance](#) that only individuals who are [essential](#) to the University's ongoing operations can remain physically on site. All other provisions of the [previously announced "stay-at-home" directive](#) remain in place.

In addition, due to the governor's new order, remote classes will be extended until at least May 4. A decision will be made by April 17 about whether we will continue [remote classes](#) beyond May 4.
