CLARIFICATION: The guidance on social distancing and events does not refer to classes scheduled for the rest of the week. All curricular activities (regardless of size) will still take place Thursday, March 12 and Friday, March 13.

Limited Public Gatherings

To implement social distancing, gatherings and meetings ***(with the exception of classes)** of more than 100 people should no longer be held on campus, effective immediately. We expect these restrictions to continue through at least April 5. We encourage using remote technology to collaborate via teleconferencing instead of meeting in person to help avoid the spread of coronavirus. Departments should cancel their space reservations for events that will no longer be taking place. Our campuses will remain open and operations will continue with appropriate measures to protect the health of the community.
